

Higher Education Pension Dispute

The GC notes

- That pre-1922 university employers have proposed to slash pensions by up to £200,000 over the duration of the pension period.
- That the University and College Union (UCU) won a 88% vote for strike action on a turnout of 58% to oppose these plans.
- Around 40,000 staff from pre-1922 universities are involved in up to 14 days of strike action.

The GC believes

- That the proposed cuts are completely unjustified and wrong

The GC resolves

- To carry out collections at all Lewisham Deptford meetings during March in support of the strike
- To send a message of solidarity to the UCU in general and Goldsmiths in particular
